- 1. Apologies for absence. Councillor McCluskey.
- 2. Approval of the minutes of the meeting on 11 April 2022. Councillor Mortimer proposed that the minutes be approved, seconded by Councillor Simpson, all in favour.
- **3. Finance.** The annual accounts have been circulated and were noted.
- 4. Chairman's Annual Report. Councillor Mortimer presented his report, this had already been circulated to the Councillors. The same report applies to all four assemblies. It will also be available on the website rudbyparishcouncil.org and is available to residents on request to the Clerk.
